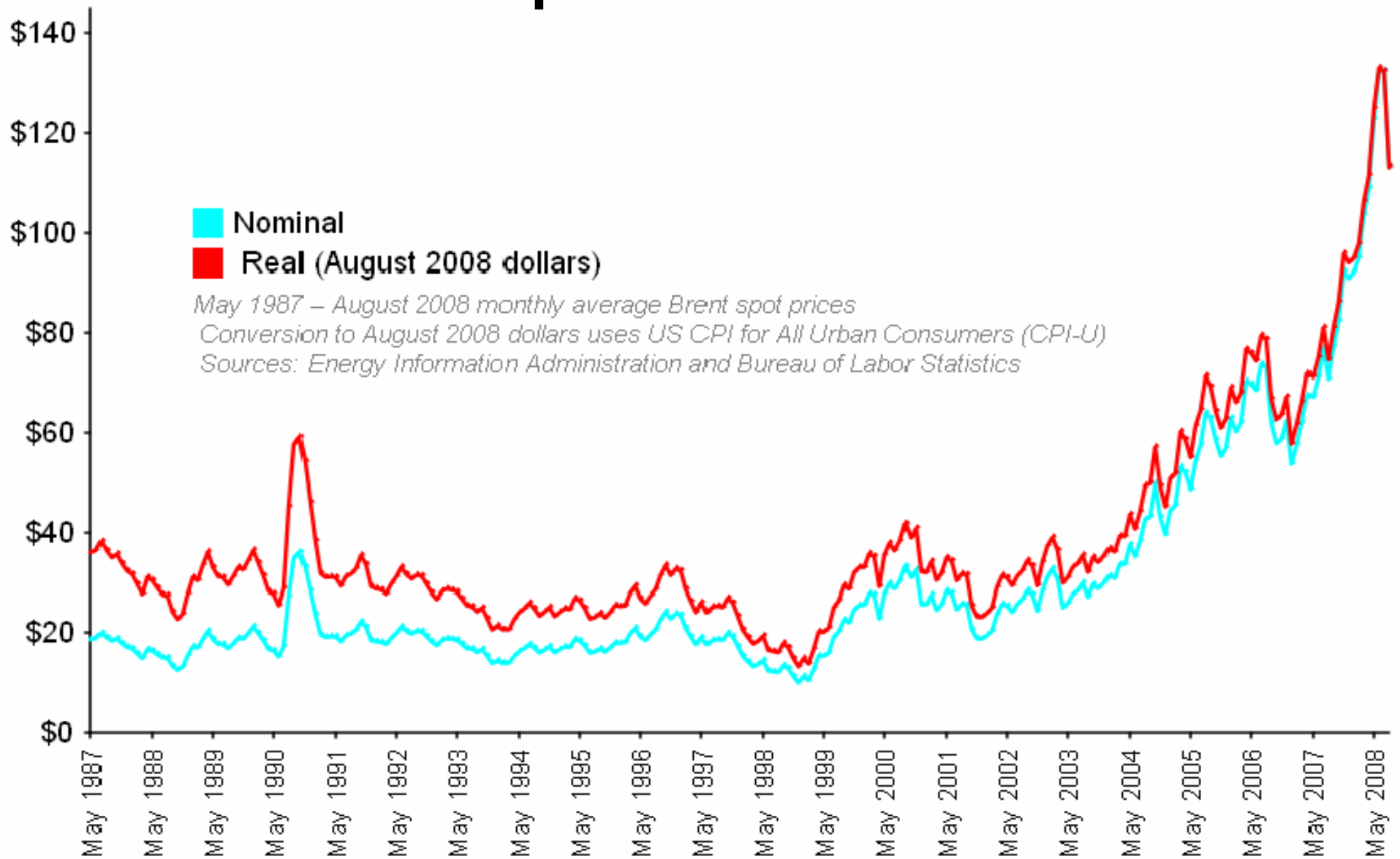

Oil price evolution



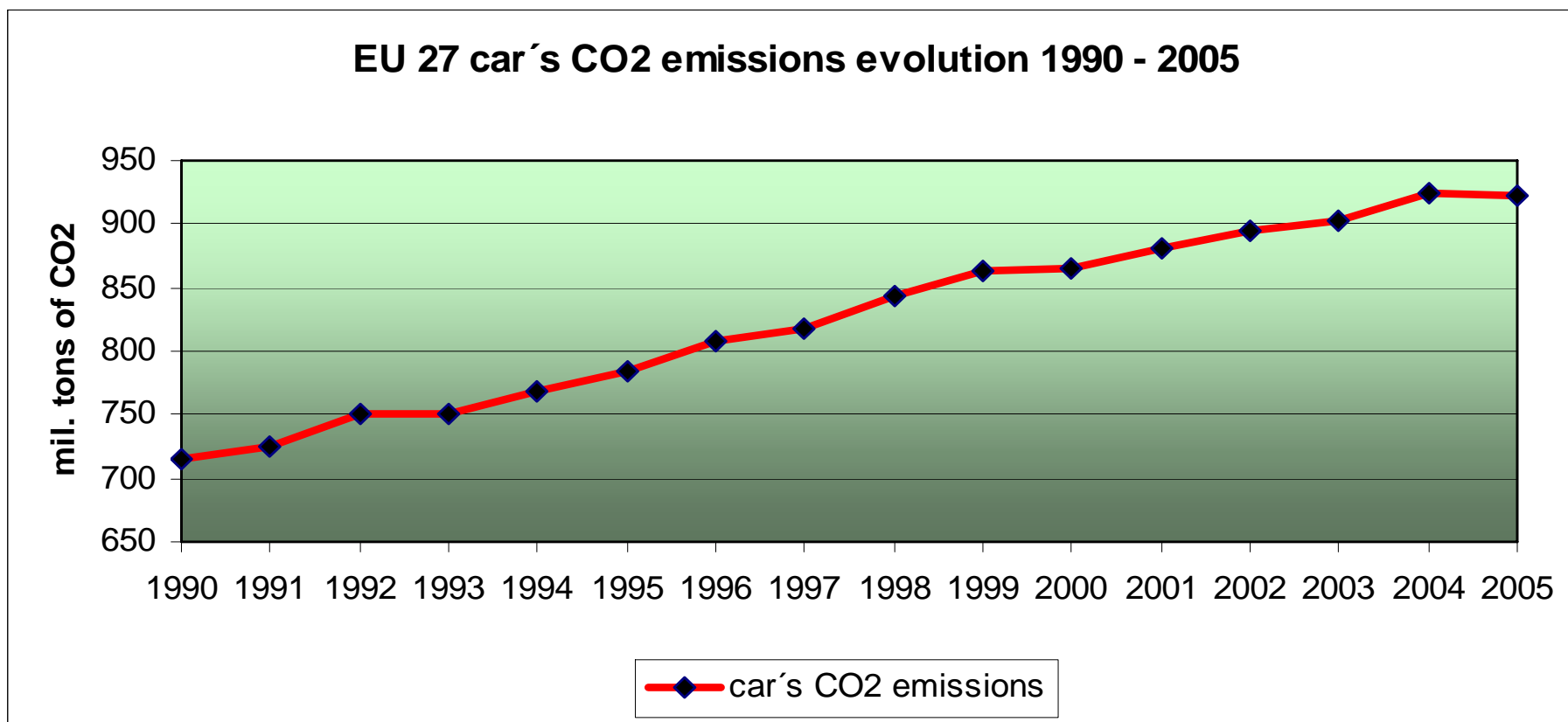

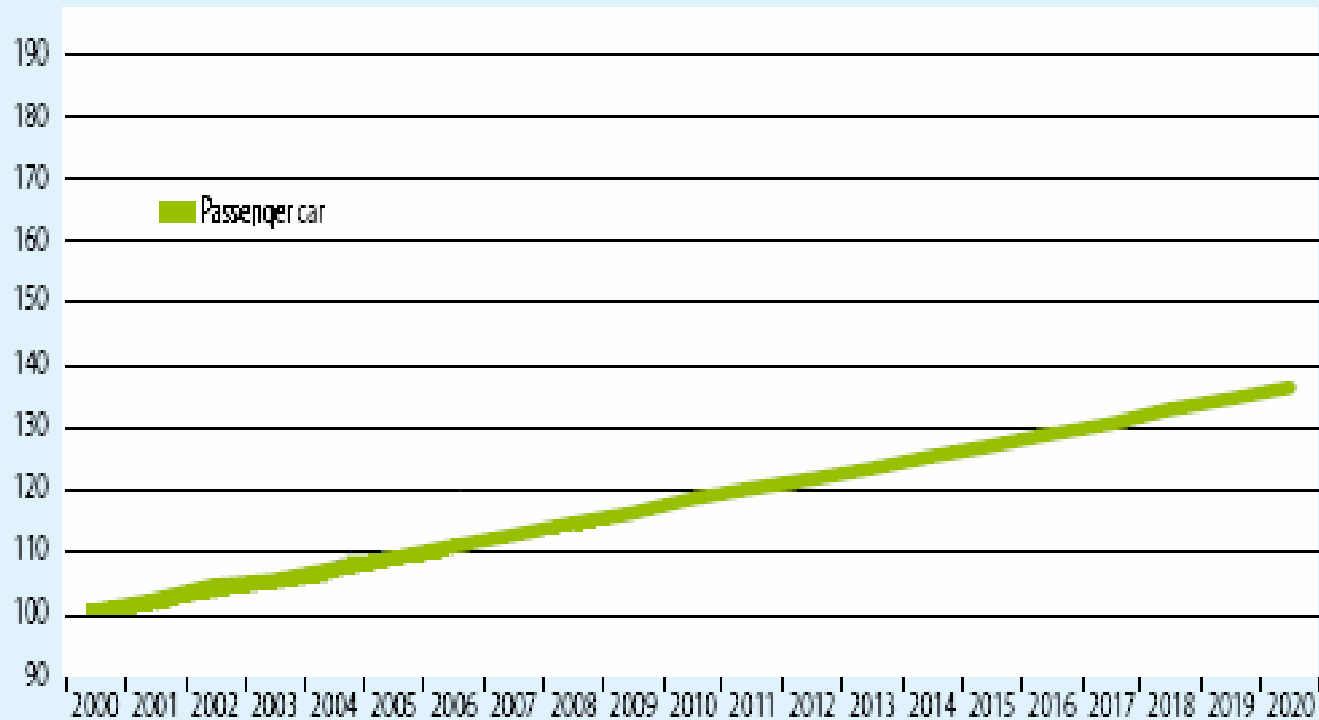
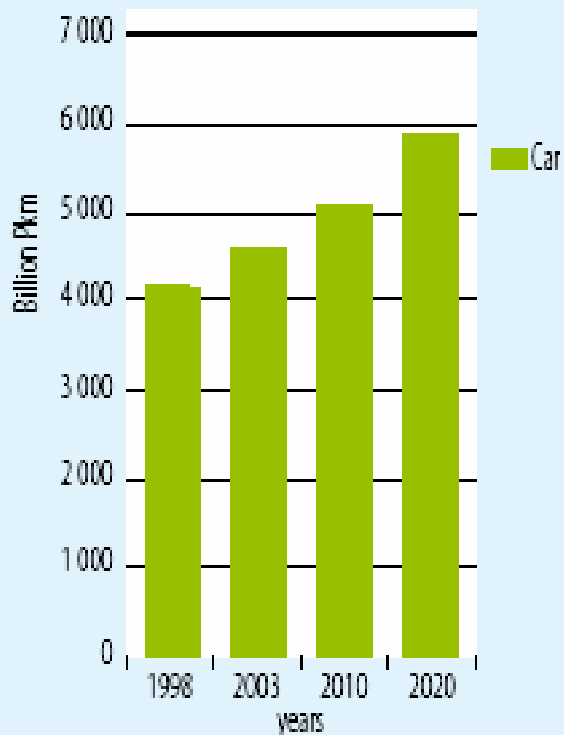
CO₂ emissions from passenger cars in EU 27

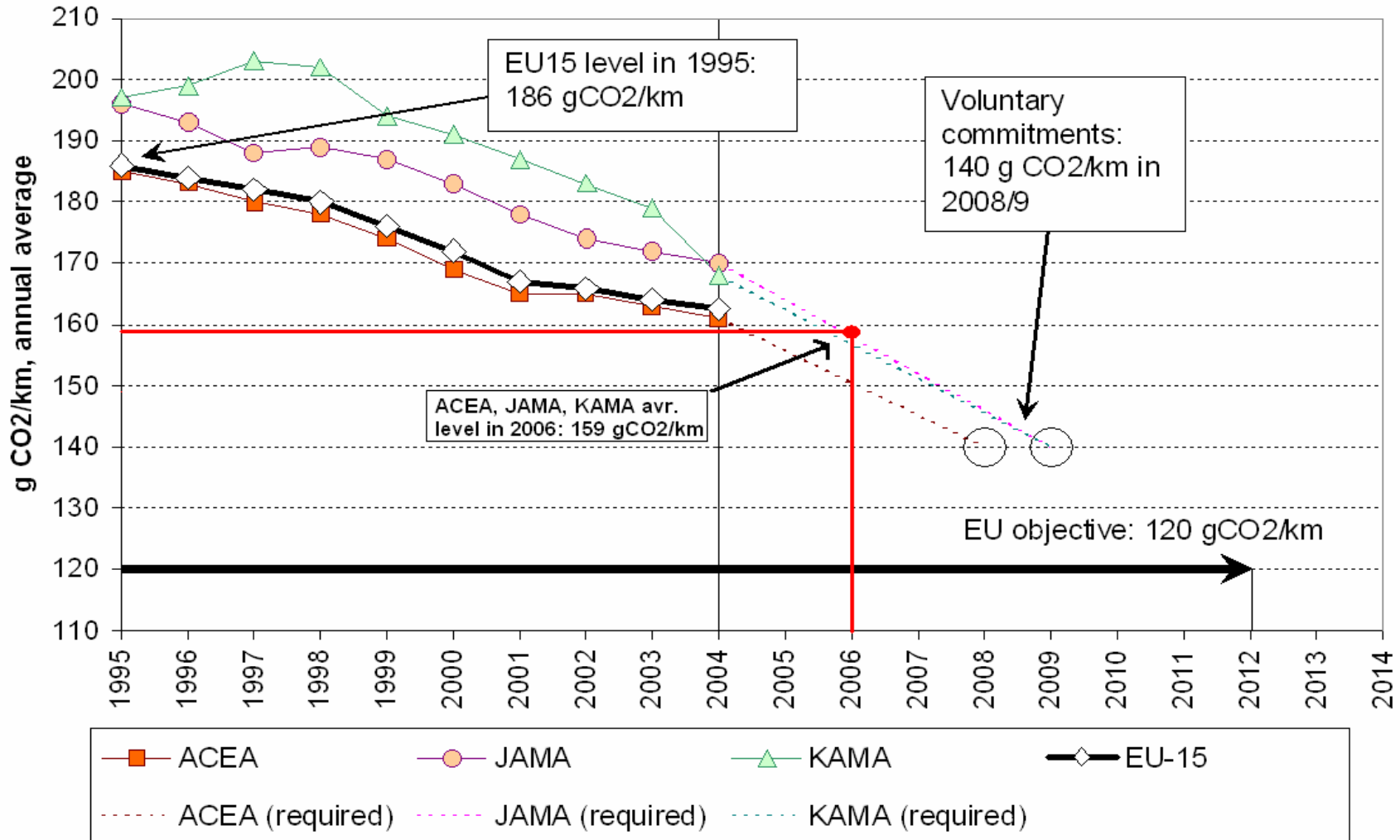
Expected growth in passenger transport activity by mode 2000=100

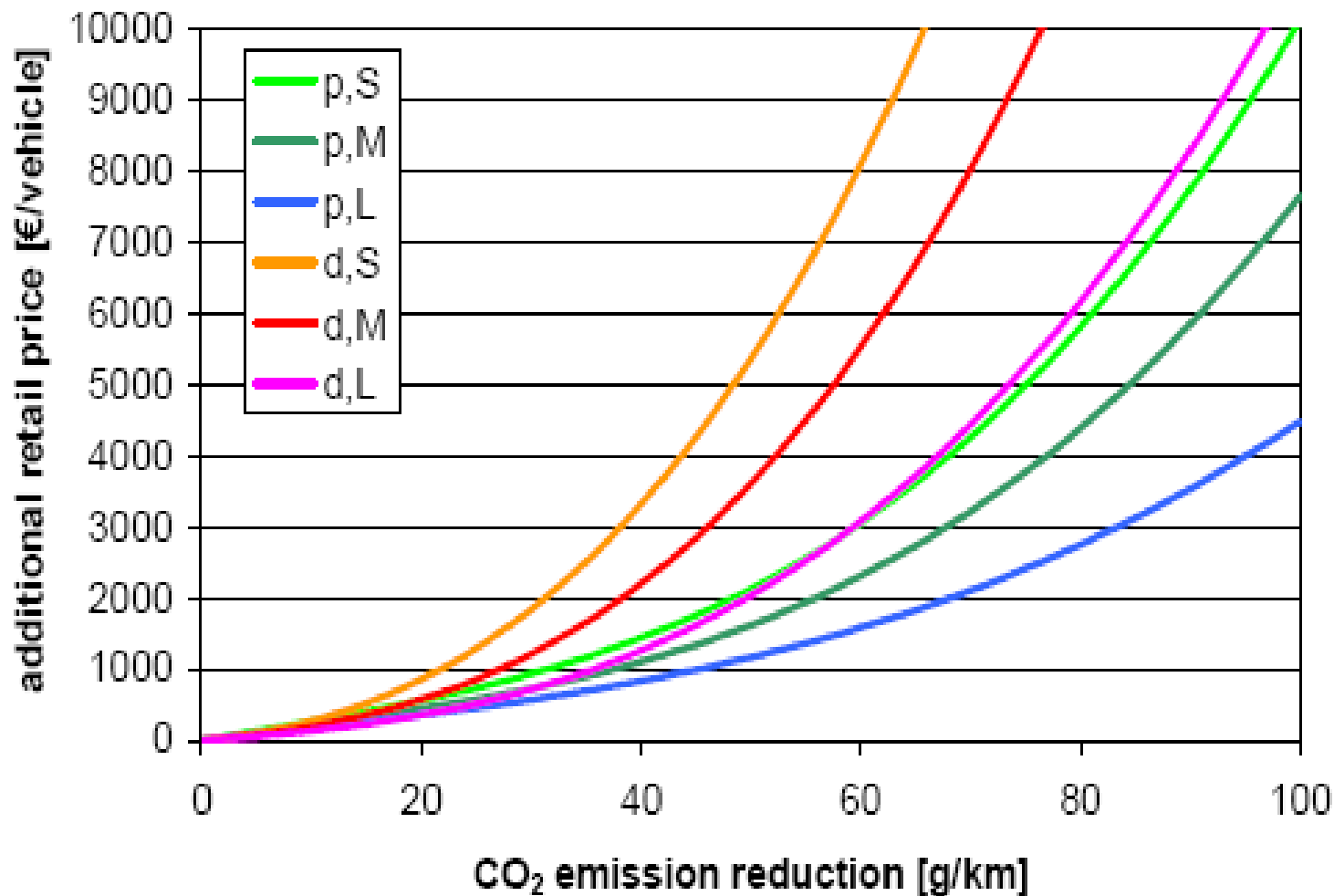
EU 15 average new car fleet CO₂ emissions between 1995 and 2004
